Subject: Pacific Island Countries and Territories Regional Exercise during Pacific Wave Exercise 2022 (PacWave22-PICT) on 9 November 2022 (Registration on 7 October and Informational Webinar on 2 November)

As announced by IOC Circular Letters <u>2894</u> and <u>2904</u>, the Intergovernmental Coordination Group for the Pacific Tsunami Warning and Mitigation System (PTWS) will conduct Exercise Pacific Wave 2022 (PacWave22) in the months of September through November 2022. PacWave22 provides a valuable opportunity for Pacific countries to engage regionally in coordination and cooperation, review their tsunami response procedures, test internal and external communication systems, and engage with communities through public education activities.

As part of this exercise, the PTWS Pacific Island Countries and Territories Regional Working Group on Tsunami Warning and Mitigation System (WG-PICT), with support from the Pacific Tsunami Warning Center (PTWC) and International Tsunami Information Center (ITIC), will be conducting a Regional Exercise for PICTs within the scope of PacWave 22 (PacWave22-PICT) to test the ICG/PTWS Hunga Tonga Hunga Ha'apai (HTHH) Interim Procedures and PTWS Products on 9 November 2022.

The objectives of PacWave22-PICT exercise are twofold:

1. Test the HTHH PTWC Interim Procedures and PTWS Products (<u>IOC Circular Letter 2902</u>), and whether the HTHH PTWS products are interpreted by PICT Member States accurately and in a timely manner, and

Test regional communication and cooperation between PICT Member States, and the value of information sharing in facilitating national tsunami alert decision-making.

The PacWave22-PICT will consist of a live tabletop exercise starting at 2300 UTC on 9 November 2022. The exercise will utilize the 15 January 2022 HTHH scenario (cf. Circular Letters <u>2877</u> & <u>2902</u>) with PTWC-simulated products. During the exercise, PICT national stakeholders (National Tsunami Warning Centres and National Disaster Management Offices) will share event information through multiple informal communications modes, including WhatsApp, electronic mail listserv, and/or HF Radio.
