## **IOC** strategic positioning

IOS Evaluation of Strategic Positioning EC-55 request to estimate needed budget and resources Assessment and Circular Letter 2912, October 2022

Conclusions: increase of workforce from 60 to 90,

staff outside RP requires more stability,

increase of budget from 30M\$ to 50M\$,

need stable "core voluntary contributions"
